Records of Deaths, 1900-1913 and Stillbirths, 1907.

This is a transcription of vital records from a bound volume of the records of the Registrar of Vital Statistics of the Village of Voorheesville, New York. The volume was formerly housed at the Village Office in Voorheesville, New York. In 2017, it was transferred to the collection of village records stored at the Voorheesville Public Library. The record book is available for examination at the library during regular library hours. It is recommended that researchers make an appointment to view this volume and other archival collections at the library.

Register of Births:

The records in this register include: date of birth, name of child (family and given name), sex, number of mother's previous children, how many now living, color or race if other than white, place of birth, mother's name (maiden and married), mother's age, mother's birthplace, father's name, father's occupation, father's age, father's birthplace, Medical Attendant or other attendant, and when registered. Birthplaces given are usually either the country or state and sometimes the city or village. Spellings of names are given as found in the records and may not be the correct spelling or other spelling of the names as found in other records. All places are in New York State unless otherwise noted. A few certificates of birth are pasted on the pages and these are given at the end of each page.

This transcription includes the child's name, birthdate, mother's last names (maiden followed by married), age and birthplace, father's name, occupation, age and birthplace. The attendants at the births are not transcribed, but were either A. M. Oliver, W.F. Shaw or Fisher Joslin. All the births took place in Voorheesville, New York. Some names are illegible and in those cases, after consulting Ancestry.com and other sources, a guesstimate of the name has been made.
