The implementation of this policy will be guided by our mission and strategic plan. Joint projects, programs and services will be contingent on the availability of library resources and priorities and will be governed by mutually agreed upon conditions set by the parties involved.

Procedures and/or agreements will be developed to ensure that supervision, liability, and insurance requirements are met.

Oversight of this policy will be the responsibility of the Library Director.

Approval of Partnerships and Sponsorships will be the responsibility of the Board of Trustees.
